

- 1. Origen refers to Paul's "fourteen" letters, apparently including Hebrews, although there is some debate as to whether the number was original since Origen does not list Hebrews in his catalog of New Testament books (Eusebius, *Ecclesiastical History* 6.25). For Origen's text see Edmon L. Gallagher and John D. Meade, *The Biblical Canon Lists from Early Christianity* (Oxford: Oxford University Press, 2017), 92.
- 2. Hebrews is not listed in Eusebius's catalogue (*Ecclesiastical History* 3.25.23), but in 3.3.5 he speaks of Paul's "14" letters, which would include Hebrews.
- 3. Origen refers to the letters of John in the plural, so presumably he means both 2 and 3 John.
- 4. There is some debate as to whether or not the Muratorian Canon includes 3 John. See Kruger, Canon Revisited, 230 n. 178.
- 5. Origen doesn't include Revelation in his lists, but he accepts it as authoritative elsewhere in his writings.
- 6. Eusebius also includes Revelation in the disputed group; see Gallagher and Meade, Biblical Canon Lists, 101 n. 126.
