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Comparisons of Passages in Mark

1:14-15

14:41-42

After John was **handed over**, Jesus came into Galilee, proclaiming the gospel of God:

The time [καιρός] has been fulfilled, and the kingdom of God has arrived.

Change your ways and believe this **gospel**.

And he comes a third time and says to them:

Continue to sleep and take your rest. It is enough.

The hour $[\omega\rho\alpha]$ has come: see, the Son of Man is handed over into the hands of sinners. Get up, let us go; see, the one who hands me over has arrived.
