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- 1. Are you ever tempted to elevate your partner or your love relationship over God Himself?
- 2. How can your partner challenge you in your relationship with God to keep it first and foremost?
- 3. What can you do to exhibit a more godly form of love toward your partner?
- 4. How can you inspire each other to express a genuine form of love toward others?
- 5. Are you more spiritually in tune or motivated as a result of your relationship together? Are you drawn closer to God? Why or why not?
- 6. Which devotional from the last five days on the topic of love was most inspiring or convicting for you? Do you have any other strong feelings or reactions from this week's topic?

WEEK TWO



- 1. What have you discovered to be most meaningful concerning the subject of God's grace?
- 2. Have you found yourself living life based upon the performance trap?
- 3. Discuss with your partner how he or she might encourage you to live life with a perspective of grace.
- 4. Talk to each other about the difference between cheap grace and free grace.
- 5. How can your partner inspire you to maintain focus on grace instead of works?

WEEK THREE



- 1. How would you evaluate your prayer life? Do you begin and end each day with prayer? Do you pray continually throughout the day? Share your answers with each other.
- 2. Everyone struggles with the discipline of prayer. It's a universal experience. Discuss your difficulties with prayer. What are the barriers and hindrances you seem to encounter?
- 3. How would you assess your ability to be authentic and real before the God of the universe?
- 4. Talk to each other about your view of God. Do you see Him as an angry older man in the sky? Do you view Him as a passive, distant grandfather in the outer cosmos? Or are you able to approach Him as He really is—a loving heavenly Father who is intimately involved and concerned about every detail of your life? Discuss your views.

- 5. How can you pray for each other? Do you share your prayer needs?
- 6. Have you committed this relationship to prayer? Have you asked God to show you how you can serve Him together? Have you asked God about what may be lacking, harmful, or unhealthy in your relationship? Talk to each other about how you might use the discipline of prayer to enhance the relationship.
- 7. Praying together is one of the greatest catalysts for intimacy in marriage. Would you and your partner be willing to start praying together as a couple? Discuss whether you are ready for this level of commitment.

WEEK FOUR



- 1. Do you have a regular time and place for meditating on God's Word?
- 2. How can you inspire each other to maintain regular study of Scripture?
- 3. What is your greatest barrier to studying God's Word?
- 4. Discuss with each other your particular approach to "renewing your mind" with the Word.
- 5. Talk with your partner about the difficulties you've experienced in discovering the will of God. How does your view of Scripture help you discern God's will?
- 6. What else can you share with your partner concerning this topic?

- 1. Do you long for a life of simplicity?

- 3. How can you encourage each other in your priorities and perspectives?

Community

- 1. Are you and your partner a member of a local church? If not, why not?
- 2. Discuss your past experiences with church.
- 3. Discuss your fantasy of the ideal church in order to clarify the things that you value most with the understanding that there is no "perfect" church this side of heaven.
- 4. Discuss what you believe to be the greatest benefits of being involved in a community of fellow believers.

- 5. Have you developed the close, intimate kinds of relationships that allow you to be encouraged, supported, and even challenged?
- 6. Do you know what your spiritual gifts are? Are you exercising these gifts?
- 7. Was there anything else from the lesson this past week that you have a strong reaction about? Feel free to discuss.

- 1. How do you define purity?
- 2. Discuss how you feel about the issue of purity.
- 3. What are your convictions regarding the need to maintain purity within your relationship?
- 4. Are you satisfied with your physical boundaries and your method for controlling your passions within this relationship?
- 5. Have you ever discussed your need for guidelines or boundaries within this arena?

- 6. Are you in need of God's forgiveness and grace concerning this area of your life?

The Spirit
