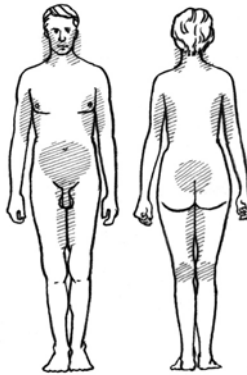

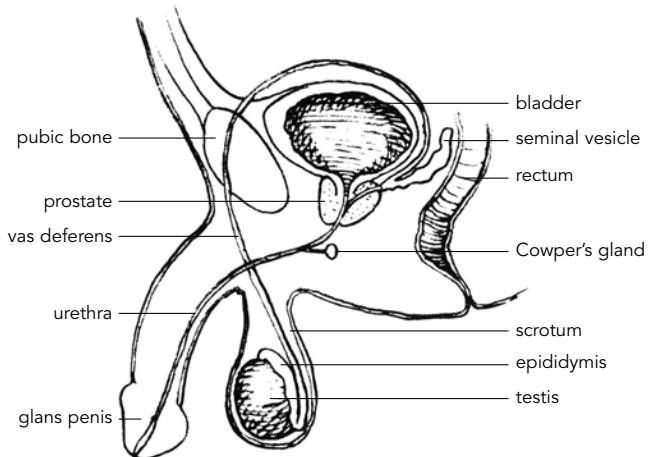

The clitoris with labia

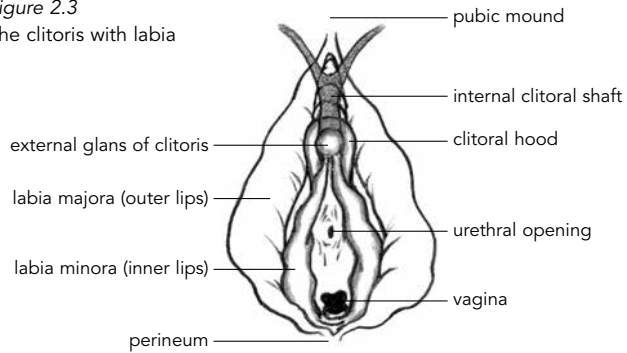
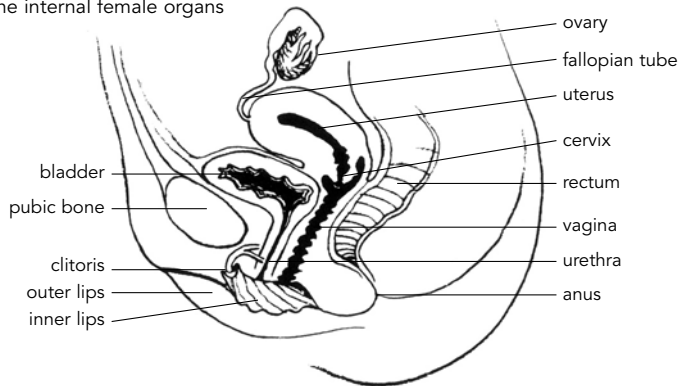


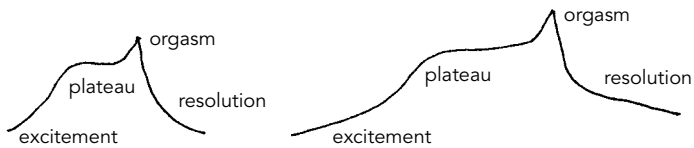

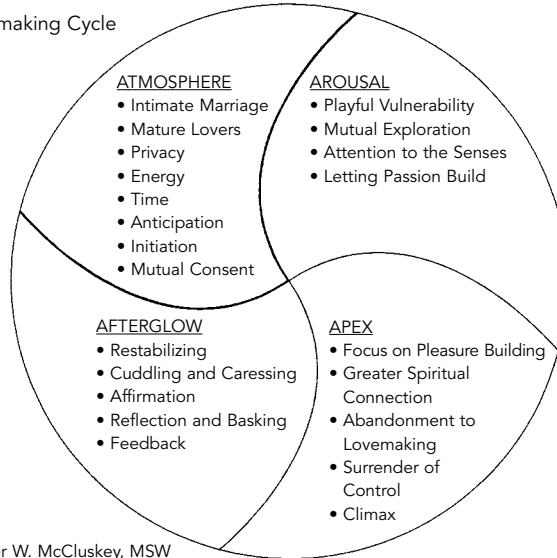
